THERE ARE TWO STEPS TO PARTICIPATE.

**First**, a student must pass one of the following exams by **May 17, 2019**:

- Adobe Certified Associate in Visual Communication using Adobe Photoshop
- Adobe Certified Associate in Print & Digital Media Publication using Adobe InDesign
- Adobe Certified Associate in Graphic Design & Illustration using Adobe Illustrator

**Second**, a student must submit a design project created using one or more of the following programs: Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign by May 17, 2019 to [www.acachampionship.com/us](http://www.acachampionship.com/us). Students with the top design projects will be invited to compete at the live event in Orlando, Florida.

\*To compete in the final round of the Competition, students must be enrolled in an approved, accredited learning institution and be between the ages of 13 and 22 (as of June 15, 2019).
