Does Unity Technologies offer certification?

Yes, Unity Technologies has various levels of certification based on your proficiency and experience. Unity has partnered with Certiport to offer the Unity Certified User (UCU) certification for validating entry-level skills for employment. Learn more at www.Certiport.com/Unity.

Why was the Unity Certified User certification created?

The industry demand for interactive content creation skills is on the rise and requires new job candidates to be able to create games, apps, AR and VR, and other experiences using Unity technology and tools.

The UCU certification helps educators effectively teach and validate interactive content creation while providing students with credentials that demonstrate real-world competence to prospective employers and academic institutions.

What are the benefits of earning a Unity Certified User certification?

When someone earns a UCU certification, it validates their technical abilities and demonstrates proficiency. Unity certifications are based on research about interactive content creation skills required by industry and government, supported by education.

Industry-recognized certification programs ensure future and current job seekers are acquiring the knowledge and abilities valued in today's workplace. For institutions seeking to keep curriculum vitalized and relevant, certification plays a critical role in bridging classroom learning to real world application.

What Unity Certified User certifications are available?

There are two UCU certifications currently available:

- Programmer
- VR Developer

What is the Unity Certified User Programmer certification?

The Programmer certification exam focuses on foundational skills in Unity and C# Programming. Individuals should have at least 150 hours of Unity software use and training.

What is the Unity Certified User VR Developer certification?

The VR Developer certification exam will test the candidate's ability to create VR experiences and programs within Unity software. The VR Developer certification can only be taken by individuals who have previously earned their Programmer certification.

How is a Unity Certified User certification earned?

To earn a UCU certification, an individual must pass a rigorous examination administered through a Certiport Authorized Testing Center (CATC). All UCU exams are created with input from industry and academic subject-matter experts and are psychometrically validated. The scenario-based questions provide real-world context for individuals getting certified.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What question formats are used in the exam?

UCU exams validate a test candidate's knowledge and skills within scenario-based contexts via selective response question types such as true and false, multiple choice, hot spot mapping or matching formats.

The UCU exams are available on Certiport's exam delivery system, Compass. Compass can be deployed on a Windows or Mac-based system. What happens when I pass a Unity Certified User exam?

As soon as you pass a UCU exam, your name and exam results are available in the Certiport portal. You have access to view and print your official certificate or can download the certification logo highlighting your accomplishment

by logging onto www.Certiport.com under Login/Register. You can also claim your digital certification badge at www.youracclaim.com.

How do I claim my digital Unity Certified User certification badge and use it?

Once you have been issued a UCU certification from Certiport, you will receive an email notification from Acclaim (admin@youracclaim.com). That email will include instructions for claiming your badge. Your badge will be tied to the same email address used for your Certiport portal account. To learn more visit support.youracclaim.com.

Do the Unity Certified User certifications expire?

The UCU certifications do not expire but the date when the certification was earned is printed on the certificate and would be considered non-current three years after that date.

What is a Site License?

Institutions can purchase an UCU Site License that includes use of the UCU certification exams with an upfront annual fee. You can upgrade your UCU Site License to include practice tests to prepare your students and staff.

How do I purchase a single exam voucher?
