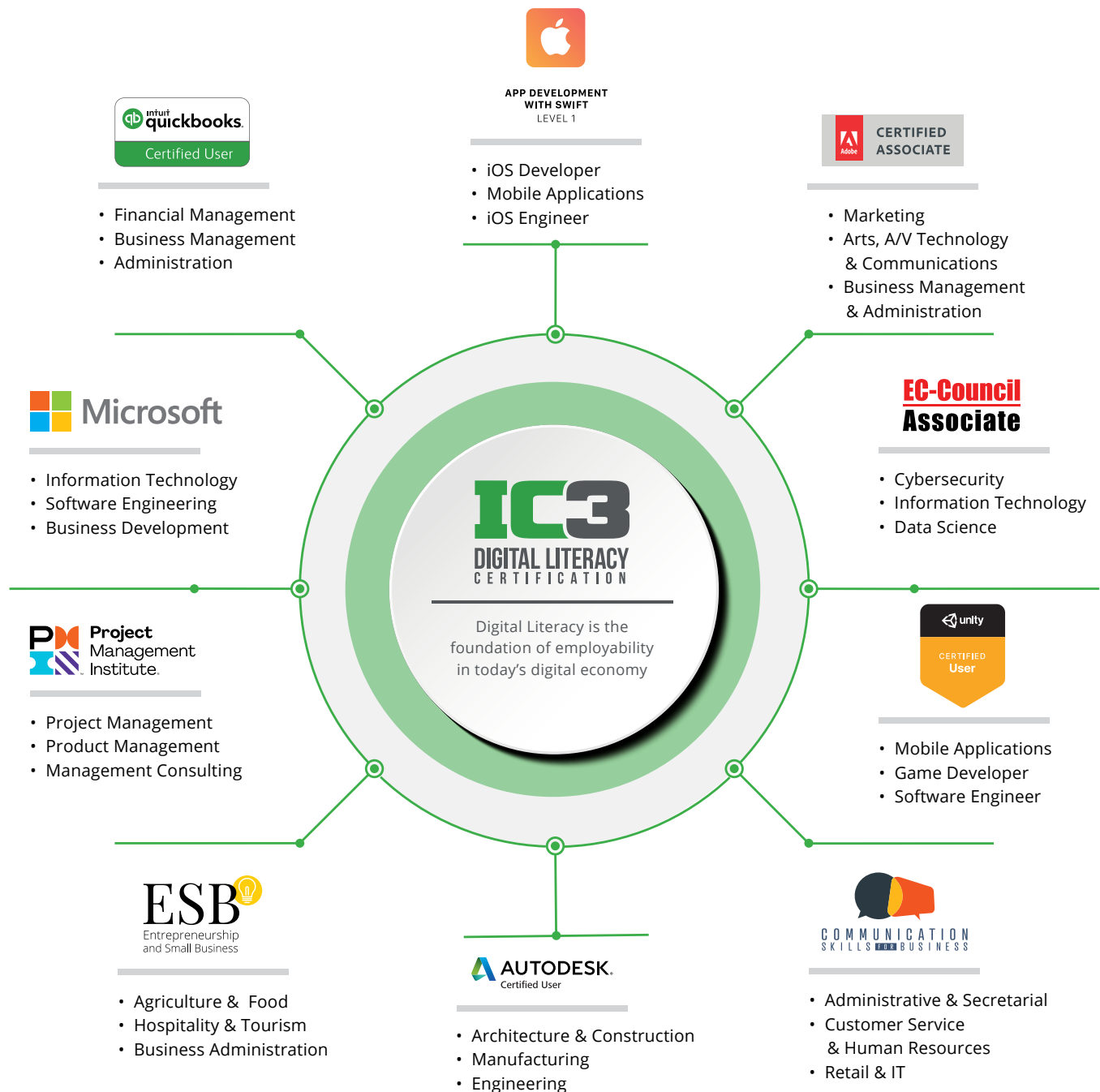

GLOBAL STANDARD SIX



LEVEL 1

Know: The Level 1 exam certifies that candidates have the foundational knowledge and basic competencies of Digital Literacy across seven competency domains.

LEVEL 2

Do: The Level 2 exam certifies a candidate's ability to do essential tasks in an online environment and within core applications across the seven objective domains.

LEVEL 3

Lead: The Level 3 exam certifies a candidate's mastery of digital literacy and their ability to manage systems, collaborate, and troubleshoot while providing guidance to others.



When a candidate successfully passes all three certification exams, they earn a master certificate and badge to display a successful completion of the IC3 Digital Literacy Program Global Standard Six.

GLOBAL STANDARD FIVE



Foundational understanding of computer hardware, software, operating systems, peripherals, and troubleshooting.



Skills to use the Internet or work in a networked environment and maximize communication, education, collaboration, and social interactions in a safe and ethical way.



Familiarity with the most common features of spreadsheets, word processing, presentation applications, and "app culture".



IC3 Spark is focused on a younger demographic for those who may have little to no experience with computers.



IC3 Fast Track is a skills assessment designed to gauge the skill of incoming students or job candidates to ensure they are ready on day one.

VALUE OF CERTIFICATION

Earning an official certification that is industry-recognized can validate the time and effort that the instructor and the learner put into mastering a subject. The certification serves as a verification of understanding the concepts associated with the learning materials and provides value to both the certificate earner and company for which they may work.

The **2018 Value of Certification Survey** by Pearson VUE* has listed the benefits of certification by asking over ten thousand certificate holders about the value they received by earning their certification. The benefits are as follows:

- 91% say that earning a certification gives them more professional credibility with those they interact with on the job.
- 90% say it is more effective at preventing or reducing gaps in learning.
- 89% say it makes them more valuable to their employer.
- 88% say it provides motivation to keep their skills up to date.
- 84% say it helps them see how different concepts are connected within a larger subject domain.
- 84% say it helps them retain acquired knowledge over a longer period.
- 67% say they had greater confidence in their abilities.
- 55% say that the knowledge has been transferable to work situations.
